Our ladies all have addiction histories and some have been to prison. We can tell you from experience that a personal relationship with Jesus Christ is the only answer to addiction. This truth is the heart of all we do at BTH and your prayers for us are critical.

In addition to Sunday and Wednesday church and counseling activities, the residents spend most of every day in classes designed to help them build their lives around their relationship with Jesus: Celebrate Recovery, Breaking Free, Purity, Seamless, WMU Circle, Bible Basics, Introduction to Christianity, Women of the Bible, Predator Men, Thin Within and exercise, sewing and art. We are so grateful for the many volunteers who come and teach, prayerwalk, perform construction and maintenance, mentor and even do game night. We praise God for the doctors, dentists and nurses who provide quality medical care.

Pray for us: 1. As we move forward now, the ladies will be speaking and serving off campus and begin to go to work off campus; 2. As we look toward graduation in August, the ladies will need cars and they will be making decisions about where to live and work and go to church; 3. All of us need spiritual, emotional and physical endurance to do the work God has called us to do.
